I. COMPETITION OVERVIEW

The 2024 Sugar Skate competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of U.S. Figure Skating, as set forth in the <u>current rulebook</u>, and current Compete USA handbook as well as any pertinent updates that have been posted on the U.S. Figure Skating <u>website</u>.

This competition is open to all eligible, restricted, reinstated or readmitted persons as defined by the Eligibility Rules.

Skaters must be a currently registered member of a U.S. Figure Skating member club, Learn to Skate USA[®] member, a collegiate club or who is an individual member in accordance with the current rulebook. For non-U.S. citizens, please refer to the <u>rulebook</u> for more information.

SERIES INFORMATION:

2024 Sugar Skate has been approved as an Excel Series competition for the 2024 competition season. As an Excel Series event, skaters entered in the Series at eligible levels will earn points for their placement in order to qualify to the Excel National Festival. Skaters must register for the Excel Series prior to competing at a designated competition by March 1, 2024. Please visit US Figure Skating's Excel webpage for more information. II. ELIGIBILITY

Singles: Excel and Well-Balanced Events:

- Skaters must meet at least the minimum singles test requirements for the event's level. A skater's singles test level may be higher than the minimum requirement.
 - Skate Up: skaters may skate up one level higher than their minimum test requirement allows.
- Skaters may not register for an event level lower than allowed by their competitive floor. An athlete's competitive floor is set by one of the following scenarios:
 - If an athlete has a paid EMS series application for the NQS series, the event level registered for in the most recent NQS will become the lowest level they may compete at in any U.S. Figure Skating sanctioned event.
 - If an athlete has a paid EMS series application for the Excel Series, the event level registered for in the most recent Excel series will become the lowest level they may compete in any Excel event. For Well-Balanced and Specialty events the skater will be permitted to register at one level lower than the "floor" set by their excel series entry.
 - If an athlete has never had a paid EMS series application in the NQS or Excel series, the athlete may select their level based on their goals and technical skills as long as the minimum test requirements are met.
- Skaters are not permitted to enter an Excel free skate and a Well-Balanced free skate event at the same competition (example: Juvenile Girls Free Skate and Juvenile Girls Excel Free Skate).
 However, they are permitted to enter an Excel and a Well-Balanced event of different types such as a short program (if stand-alone event option), specialty or showcase events (example: Intermediate Women Short Program and Intermediate Women Excel Free Skate).

All other singles (Adults):

- Skaters must meet the minimum test requirements for the events level, but not exceed the maximum permissible test requirement.

COMPLIANCE:

COACHES

To be an eligible coach at a nonqualifying competition, coaches must meet the applicable compliance requirements and verified by U.S. Figure Skating. Coach compliance falls into two categories, Coach Compliance (includes choreographers) and Learn to Skate USA[®] Instructor Compliance. Details regarding compliance requirements can be found <u>HERE</u>. All compliance requirements must be met at the time of check-in to access the competition, no exceptions.

<u>Coaches of foreign athletes:</u> If you are a coach of a foreign athlete only, you are not subject to U.S. Figure Skating coach compliance and will only be asked to provide a letter of good standing for the federation your athlete represents.

There will be one coach credential per registered athlete.

With EMS, coaches must be included within a skater/team's registration or updated through their EMS Skater Portal via "My Coaches" or "Team Personnel." All coaches declared at the time of registration will be included on the registration confirmation email. Note: There is no registration approval process within EMS as the data (membership and test level) is tied to the U.S. Figure Skating database. Non-compliant coaches will receive automated email reminders through the start of the competition.

Online registrations will be accepted via <u>EMS</u>. Payment must be made at the time of registration by <u>credit</u> <u>card only</u>. Each transaction includes a 3% transaction fee.

FOREIGN SKATERS:

Non-U.S. skaters intending to register for this competition must set up a non-member account prior to registering for the competition (<u>click here for HOW TO</u>). This can be done by choosing the "Non-Member? Create Account" option on the Members Only login page.

TEST CREDIT:

Test credit will be offered for a \$25 fee. It must be requested prior to the competition through the EMS Competition Portal under "Merchandise". You may pick up your test credit paperwork at the registration desk within 1 hour after awards have been presented for the event.

MUSIC SUBMISSION/UPLOAD:

EMS MUSIC UPLOAD: Competitors participating in events with music are required to upload their music to EMS no later than March 1st 11:59PM ET. After this date, skaters will be locked out of this feature and subject to a \$40 late fee. The late fee will automatically be added to each skater's cart who doesn't meet this requirement by the deadline. Late fees will not be removed under any circumstances and must be paid prior to receiving the skater credential onsite. DEADLINE: 03/01/2024 LATE FEE: \$40

Competitors must also have available a backup copy of their competition music on a cell phone and it must be immediately available rinkside whenever the skater competes. If the phone does not have the standard round headset connector, an appropriate adapter, such as an Apple Lightning connector or Samsung USB-C adapter is required to be attached. The phone should be presented to the music person with the file ready to play, phone in airplane mode and volume turned to maximum.

PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT (PPC) SUBMISSION/UPLOAD - FOR IJS EVENTS ONLY:

EMS PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT (PPC) – Competitors participating in IJS events are required to submit PPC in EMS no later than March 1 11:59 PM ET. After this date, skaters will be locked out of this feature in EMS and subject to a \$40 late fee. The late fee will automatically be added to each skater's cart who doesn't meet this requirement by the deadline. Late fees will not be removed under any circumstances and must be paid prior to receiving the skater credential onsite.

All single skater events will still compete with one skater and will receive a medal.

IV. COMPETITION DETAILS

FACILITIES:

Sugar Land Ice & Sports Center 16225 Lexington Blvd., Sugar Land, TX 77479 https://www.sugarlandice.com/index.html The rink has 2 sheets of ice with bleachers in both rinks. Each ice surface is 200' X 85' with rounded corners. There is a restaurant in the facility.

LOCKER ROOMS AND CHANGING AREAS:

Athletes are expected to arrive at the arena ready (costumes, hair, make-up etc.). Athletes will be provided with benches throughout the rink, as well as tables and chairs, etc. to put skates on but changing will not be permitted in these spaces.

For those with schedule conflicts (multiple events) or travel needs, locker rooms will be made available <u>by request/reservation only.</u> You will be assigned a locker room and time frame that you are allowed in the locker rooms. Please check the club website (after the schedule is made available) for the link to reservations.

U.S. Figure Skating Travel Policy:

All travel must strictly adhere to Two-Deep Leadership requirements. An Adult Participant cannot transport a Minor Athlete one-on-one and Two-Deep Leadership requirements must be adhered to at all times during In-Program travel, by transporting at least two minors or a second Adult Participant. An Adult Participant cannot share a hotel room or other sleeping arrangement with a Minor Athlete(s). Full details of the SkateSafe® Travel Policy and any exceptions can be found starting on page 12 of the <u>SkateSafe® Handbook</u>.

OFFICIAL WEBSITE & UPDATES:

An official bulletin board will be maintained between the rinks. It is the responsibility of each competitor, parent and coach to check the bulletin board frequently for any schedule changes and/or additional information. Skaters are requested to arrive 60 minutes prior to the scheduled time of their event. A tentative schedule of events will be posted prior to the competition.

LIVE SCORING LINK:

This competition will use the live results from USFS. The link will be posted on the club website.

SCHEDULE

<u>Competitors may be scheduled on any day or time during the announced dates of the competition</u>. The competition and practice ice schedule will be available after the close of entries. All participants will be notified via email once available.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENT AND THE COACH TO MAKE SURE THE SKATER IS REGISTERED FOR THE CORRECT EVENT. THERE WILL BE A \$40 CHANGE FEE FOR ANY SCHEDULE REQUESTS AND CHANGES MADE AFTER THE CLOSE OF THE COMPETITION REGISTRATION ON FEBRUARY 16, 2024.



Schedules are made based on judges' availability, ice time available, other events scheduled, and several other considerations. We cannot accept any schedule changes or requests. Please make certain that you can compete on any day of the event dates. A tentative schedule is found in this announcement but CAN CHANGE!!! There will be no refunds.

PRACTICE ICE:

All practice ice will be available for purchase online via the EMS competition portal. Please note that you need to go BACK INTO YOUR EMS ACCOUNT after registering to purchase practice ice. You will have access to purchase one practice ice session per event registered. Additional practice ice will be offered for sale after pre-sales, if available.

A timeline for practice ice sales periods will be available for viewing on the Competition Information page of your skater portal. Practice ice will be available for purchase on a first come, first served basis on EMS. Premium (mid-day) practice ice will be offered if time permits.

Practice Ice Sessions will be 20 minutes.

The BL WYLIE TROPHY will be awarded to the skater placing 1st in the Well balanced Preliminary Free Skate Event. (Based on the highest score in the Preliminary FS event(s).
